**Paul McDonald**  
**Boys Coach**

The name "McDonald" is synonymous with Minnesota basketball. Paul played four seasons for his father, the legendary Bob McDonald, at Chisholm High School, winning two state

championships while helping the Bluestreaks to a four-year record of 98-8. Paul left Chisholm for the college game (Nebraska and South Dakota State) before jumpstarting his coaching career at the high school level in Cotton and Tower-Soudan. He recently completed his 23rd season as head coach at Vermillion Community College, where he's captured state, region and district Coach of the Year honors. Paul, known for implementing an up-tempo, exciting brand of basketball, also is a two-time finalist for the NJCAA National Coach of the Year award. He's sent nine of his players to the Division I level.



**Dan Zbosnik**  
**Girls Coach**

Dan has led Mesabi Range College to the postseason 11 of the past 12 seasons. His team is coming off a 26-6 mark that included Mesabi's fourth consecutive championship in the MCAC's

Northern Division and a No. 8 ranking in the final NJCAA national poll. An Eveleth native, Dan has coached the Lady Norse to five division titles, an MCAC state consolation crown and two trips to the NJCAA Region XIII title tilt during his 15-year tenure. His teams are renowned for their defensive tenacity and run-and-gun style. Dan has coached 38 All-Division players, 17 All-MCAC players, 12 NJCAA All-Region players and three All-Americans. Additionally, his program has captured a bevy of academic awards, including 24 All-MCAC Academic players, two Academic All-Americans and two Distinguished Academic All-Americans.

### **Damien Paulson** **Boys Coach**

A native of Culver, Minn., Damien recently completed his first season as head coach at Fond du Lac Tribal and Community College. Before Fond du Lac, Damien was a fixture on the AlBrook High

School bench, including a five-year run as head coach of the Falcons. In 2010, he led AlBrook to the Section 7A championship game and was named Region 7A Coach of the Year. The Falcons also captured two conference crowns under Damien's watch. Before he got into coaching – he also boasts 15 years of baseball coaching experience at Albrook, along with a lengthy stint in the ultra-successful Northern Lights girls basketball program – Damien played four seasons at Minnesota Duluth, where he was a team captain and MVP. He earned All-Conference status as a senior.



### **John Bauer** **Girls Coach**

John breathed new life into the women's program when he arrived at Itasca Community College in 2001. The Lady Vikings have won 20 games in five of the past seven seasons, dominating

the Minnesota College Athletic Conference's Northern Division during that stretch. It's no surprise, then, that John has captured division Coach of the Year honors four times. Itasca finished third at the MCAC State Tournament in 2004-05, first in 2005-06 and was the consolation champion a year later. Each of those three seasons, the Lady Vikings were NJCAA Regional runner-ups. John, who went to Grand Rapids High School before attending Itasca and Bemidji State, has seen three of his athletes garner All-American accolades.
