Paul McDonald **Boys Coach**

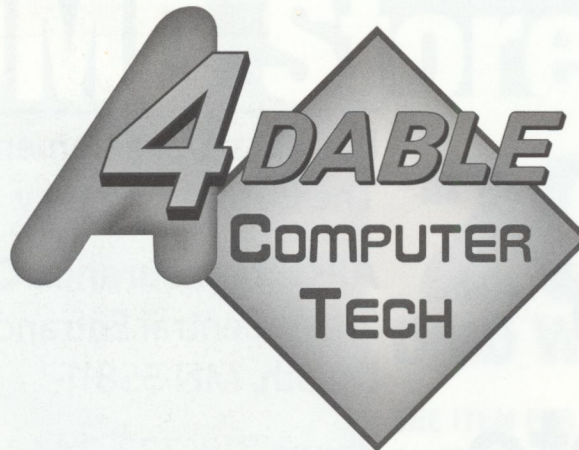
The name "McDonald" is synonymous with Minnesota basketball. Paul played four seasons for his father, Bob McDonald, at Chisholm High School, winning two state titles while helping the Bluestreaks to a four-year record of 98-8. Paul left Chisholm for the college game (Nebraska and South Dakota State) before starting his coaching career at the high school level in Cotton and Tower-Soudan. He recently completed his 24th season as head coach at Vermillion Community College, where he's captured state, region and district Coach of the Year honors. Paul, who recently reached 400 career wins at Vermilion, is a two-time finalist for the NJCAA National Coach of the Year award. He's sent nine players to the Division I level and has coached 12 All-Americans.



Dan Zbosnik **Girls Coach**

Dan, the former coach at Mesabi Range College, led his team to the postseason in 11 of 12 tries. In 2011-12, Mesabi went 26-6 and won its fourth consecutive championship in the MCAC's Northern Division and earned a No. 8 ranking in the final NJCAA national poll. An Eveleth native, Dan coached the Lady Norse to five division titles, an MCAC state consolation crown and two trips to the NJCAA Region XIII title tilt during his 15-year tenure. His teams were renowned for their defensive tenacity and run-and-gun style. Dan coached 38 All-Division players, 17 All-MCAC players, 12 NJCAA All-Region players and three All-Americans. Additionally, his program captured a bevy of academic awards, including 24 All-MCAC Academic players, two Academic All-Americans and two Distinguished Academic All-Americans.

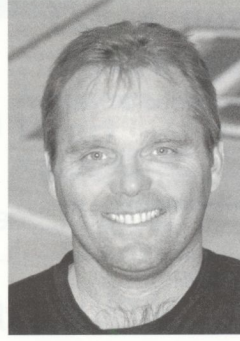

School bench, including a five-year run as head coach of the Falcons. In 2010, he led Albrook to the Section 7A title game and was named Region 7A Coach of the Year. The Falcons also captured two conference crowns under Damien's watch. Before he got into coaching — he also boasts 15 years of baseball coaching experience at Albrook, along with a lengthy stint in the ultra-successful Northern Lights AAU girls basketball program — Damien played four seasons at Minnesota Duluth, where he was a team captain and MVP. He earned All-Conference status as a senior.

John breathed life back into the women's program at Itasca Community College when he arrived 12 years ago. Over that time, his teams have won a Minnesota College Athletic Conference

state championship, four Northern Division championships and have been NJCAA 13-B regional runner-ups three times. John is a graduate of Grand Rapids High School, Itasca Community College and Bemidji State University.

BORDER BATTLE HISTORY

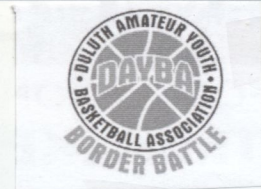
