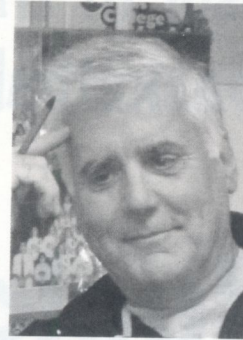
Bob & Joel McDonald Boys Coaches

The name McDonald is synonymous with Minnesota basketball, and we're thrilled to have not one, but two of 'em on the bench tonight. Bob recently capped his illustrious career as just the 13th high school boys coach nationwide to win more than 1,000 games. He coached at Chisholm High School for 52 seasons — 59 overall — and led the Bluestreaks to three state titles while building a first-class program whose players were renowned for wearing shirts and ties and close-cropped haircuts.



Joel

Bob's youngest son, Joel, has been the boys coach at Hibbing High School since 2000. During his playing days for his father at Chisholm, he became one of the most prolific scorers in state history.



Mike Turnbull Girls Coach

A 1977 graduate of Ely High School, Mike has been the head women's basketball coach at Hibbing Community College since 2007. He also serves as the women's volleyball coach, and guided the men's

basketball and baseball teams for lengthy stints upon his arrival in 1997. His Hibbing squads have advanced to 13 state tournaments and six region tournaments. They've won two conference titles and one region tournament while appearing in one national tournament. Mike has coached five All-Americans and nine Academic All-Americans. His coaching and teaching career started in 1981, and he made stops at several Minnesota high schools before being hired at Central Lakes College in Brainerd in 1993, where he stayed until his current Iron Range post beckoned.

A native of Culver, Minn., Damien recently completed his third season as head men's coach at Fond du Lac Tribal and Community College. Before Fond du Lac, Damien was a fixture on the AlBrook

High School bench, including a five-year run as head coach of the Falcons. In 2010, he led AlBrook to the Section 7A title game and was named Region 7A Coach of the Year. The Falcons also captured two conference crowns under Damien's watch. Before he got into coaching — he also boasts 15 years of baseball coaching experience at AlBrook, along with a lengthy stint in the ultra-successful Northern Lights AAU girls basketball program — Damien played four seasons at Minnesota Duluth, where he was a team captain and MVP. He earned All-Conference status as a senior.



John Bauer
Girls Coach

John has been the head women's basketball coach at Itasca Community College for the past 13 years, amassing an overall record of 181-159. Over that time, his teams have won a Minnesota community college state championship and four Northern Division championships. Additionally, they have been NJCAA 13B regional runner-ups three times, and have appeared in eight Minnesota state community college tournaments. John also has been named Northern Division Coach of the Year four times and has produced four NJCAA All-Americans. John is a graduate of Grand Rapids High School, Itasca Community College and Bemidji State University.

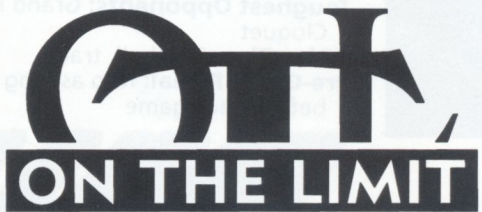

Mike was an integral part of DAYBA since its inception in 1993. He worked tirelessly to provide basketball opportunities for young people in Duluth and beyond, including our recreational and travel leagues, the huge Spirit of the North tournament and the ever-growing Border Battle All-Star series. It's safe to say that all of these undertakings far exceeded the size and scope originally intended, and

that is a tribute to Mike, who had a knack for producing high-quality events — with every 'I' dotted and 'T' crossed — that others wanted to be a part of.

Thousands of youngsters passed through, or benefited from, DAYBA in some way, shape or form during Mike's 20 years on the board, the majority of which he served as our chairman.

Away from the gym, Mike, a devoted family man, was equally active in the community. Each spring, he arranged and oversaw restoration projects for local nonprofits through his employment at Lakehead Painting and his role as an instructor for apprentice painters. Not surprisingly, he earned numerous community service awards.

Through it all, Mike always wore a smile that perfectly matched his quick wit. He was compassionate, selfless and always encouraging, and he never turned down an opportunity to lend a helping hand.

Thus, it is DAYBA's pleasure to award the Mike Gerber MVP to one outstanding player from the girls game and one from the boys game, as well as a monetary donation to their respective school's scholarship fund.
